If we continue to behave in a way that does not reflect our values of respect, responsibility or resilience we will be given a red, consequence card.

If we swear at or hurt anyone we will be given a red card.



After we have reflected on our behaviour, we will be given a consequence that will help us to learn and grow from our mistakes.

We know that every child at our school deserves to be here and we will never label, make judgement or think we are better than anyone else.
