

Knebworth Expectations

- Children should be in school and ready to start at 9:00am (KS2 children can arrive from 8:50am). Doors will be locked at 9:00am and children who arrive after this time should enter via the office.

<p>Home learning: Monday: Spellings given for Thursday partner test and Friday dictations. Wednesday: English/maths homework handed out (alternated each week). Due Monday Friday: Times table tests – children to practice these over the course of the week with particular focus on 3, 4, 6 and 8 times tables. The order of times tables are as follows: 2, 5, 10 (Recap year 1&2 learning) 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12 Home learning tasks will be discussed with the children and placed in their homework books and on class dojo for you to see.</p> <p>Spelling: Spelling rules will be introduced on Mondays.
