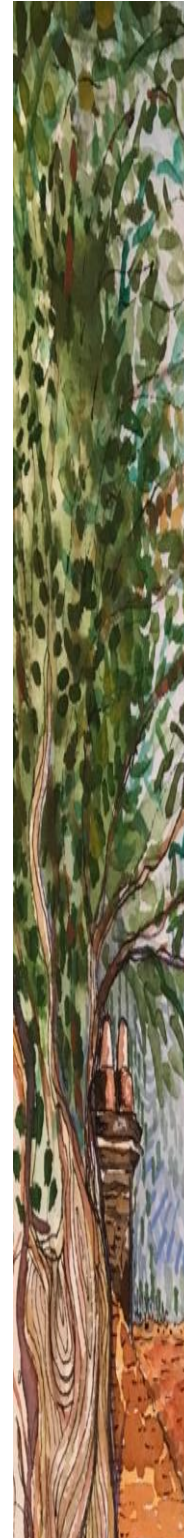


## Knebworth Expectations

<p><b>Home learning:</b> Weekly spelling pattern – in diary on Monday. Add words found and share on Wednesday. Tested through dictation on Friday. Wednesday: English/maths homework handed out (alternated each week). Due following Monday Friday: Times table tests – children to practice these over the course of the week with particular focus on 3, 4, 6 and 8 times tables. The order of times tables are as follows: 2, 5, 10 (Recap year 1&amp;2 learning) 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12 Home learning tasks will be discussed with the children and placed in their homework books and on class dojo for you to see.</p> <p><b>Spelling:</b> We do daily practice of the spelling patterns which starts with a review of the previous year’s learning. We will be looking at vowel digraphs and suffixes.</p>
